

Muldoon's Amazing 10-point Tour Check List



1. It is never too early to start organising and taking deposits.
2. Get your core group committed and sorted first (ie. the ones who are good at paying early), before chasing the others.
3. Book flights first and don't give credit to anyone.
4. Book family rooms at nice hotels for 4/5 people vs twin rooms at average hotels.
5. Organise dinner every evening before you get there. Book tables of 8 maximum and split the group up (it'll be easier to get into restaurants and they won't require deposits before arriving)
6. Genuinely book dinners early. I can't emphasise enough the importance of ensuring people are fed and watered every day.
7. Be extremely transparent with the itinerary (I give a morning and evening itinerary for every day we're away sent months in advance). Save the little surprises, but give plenty of warning on what to expect.
8. Provide an example list of likely things your tourist will need in their bag.
9. Don't accept special requests, for example 'such and such would like to share a room with such and such'.
10. Your group need cash, not cards, every day. Set a daily budget and ensure they have that amount on arrival at the airport in the required currency.
